The Member of Church Staff is called upon to fulfill a variety of roles within the church. These roles include the following:

- g. Operates, and trains others to operate as needed the church's sound and projection systems.
- h. Gain experience in developing reports for Church Council on operating budgets, and revenue & expenses.
- i. Attend regular Staff meetings, including monthly Church Council meetings.
- j. Keep congregation well informed about the church's educational ministries by using bulletin boards, the Sunday bulletin, the monthly newsletter, and the church website.
- k. Performs other duties as assigned by the Pastor and/or Church Council.
